NOTES:

- In order to compete, Novice and CP horses must be 4 years old or older; Open horses must be 5 years or older.
- All juniors under 18 are required to wear an ASTM/SEI, Snell or approved equal riding helmet when mounted on any equine at any time.
- Juniors may choose to ride in weight classes in Open and Novice Divisions if they meet the weight requirements.
- Each junior rider will receive a rider liability waiver for both parents to sign. Bring the signed waiver to the ride or return by mail.
- All riders and workers must sign waivers at the ride.
