MANAGEMENT'S RESPONSIBILITY TO THE RULES' INTERPRETER

1. RULES' INTERPRETER should be selected with care and well in advance of the ride. The RULES INTERPRETER MUST BE A CURRENT MEMBER OF NATRC AND FAMILIAR WITH THE RULES. The ideal Rules' Interpreter: national or regional board member, other ride chair, judge, or experienced NATRC rider.
2. RULES' INTERPRETER should be listed on the SIX-WEEK PROGRESS REPORT.
3. Ride management should send a ride entry to the Rules' Interpreter.
4. Ride management is responsible for providing meals and overnight accommodations for the Rules' Interpreter. Some reimburse gasoline expense.
5. Ride management should provide a RULES' INTERPRETER PACKET. This packet should include ride maps with information regarding time, number of P&Rs, lunch, ride schedule, ride roster, and name tag.
6. Rules' Interpreter should be given an "Information Sheet and Check List" prior to the ride so s/he will be familiar with the forms.
7. Rules' Interpreter should be introduced to all Ride Officials and the riders at the first briefing.
8. Arrangements should be made for the Rules' Interpreter's transportation for observation and all observing aspects of the ride, including the P&R areas, teams, procedures, judging spots, two-mile point, train conditions, markings, etc.
9. Rules' Interpreter should NOT be given any "compromising duties" such as trail master, timer, P&R team, etc.
