

NATRC STATE LIABILITY WAIVER - PAGE 2

ARKANSAS Chapter 20, §16-120-201 (1995)

WARNING

Under Arkansas law, an equine activity sponsor is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risk of equine activities.

I have noted the warning above and/or posted at the ride sign-in location and acknowledge the following:

The foregoing liability waiver additionally waives all liability of NATRC and its affiliates which arises from the “inherent risks” of an equine activity.

“Inherent risk of an equine activity” also means a danger or condition that is an integral part of an equine activity, including, but not limited to, any of the following:

- (a) The propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, death, or loss to persons on or around the equine;
- (b) The unpredictability of an equine’s reaction to sounds, sudden movement, unfamiliar objects, person, or other animals;
- (c) Hazards, including, but not limited to, surface or subsurface conditions;
- (d) A collision with another equine, another animal, a person, or an object;
- (e) The potential of an equine activity participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, death, or loss to the person of the participant or to other persons, including but not limited to, failing to maintain control over an equine or failing to act within the ability of the participant.
