Leisure Division (LeD) Judge – Application Requirements

- Must have completed a minimum of 750 miles; 500 miles must be in any combination of Open, CP and Novice classes, the additional 250 miles may be in LeD classes.
- Must have fulfilled the duties of horsemanship judge secretary.
- Must have a thorough understanding of NATRC rules, the LeD Judge's and LeD Management Manuals.
- Must pass a written exam, and upon completion, must participate in an LeD Judges Training seminar.

Upon satisfactory completion of the above, the judges committee may approve the applicant as an apprentice judge.
